Will turn any girl's heart—he is truly the take.*

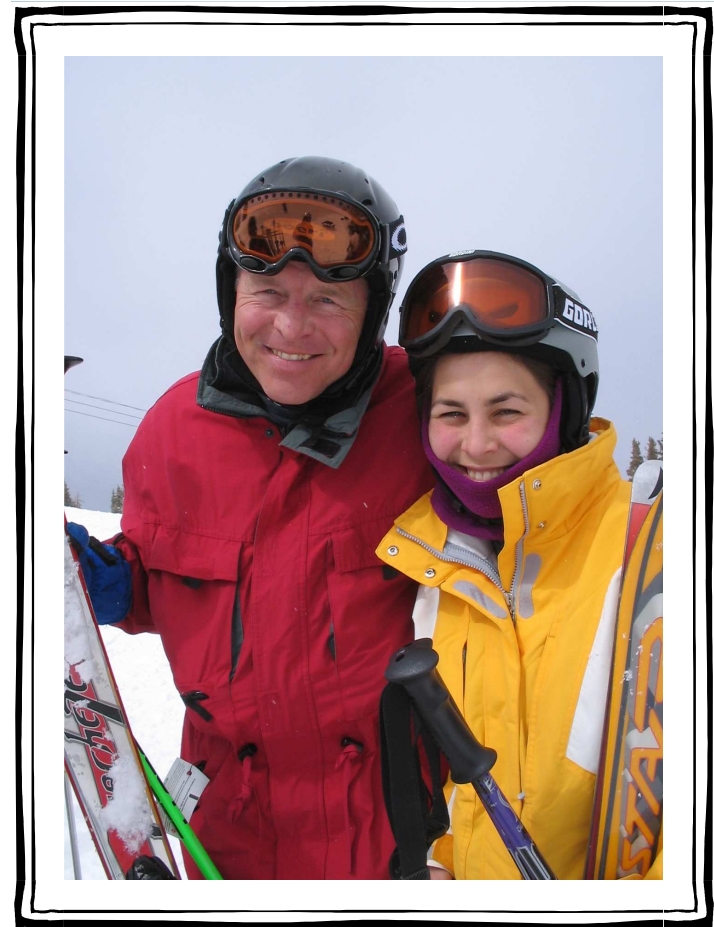
*What I want most in a man like my dad,
